First, I would like to take the opportunity to thank Commissioner Larry Walden, John Forrest and Crickett Miller for asking to meet with us on October 20, 2021. It is always nice to meet with county officials who are willing to hear and perceive what their constituents are conveying to them. Jenn, has been sharing correspondence prior to and following our meeting on October 20, 2021 and I would like to follow up on a few items regarding the most recent e-mail response from Crickett and the aforementioned meeting at the Parker County Annex. During our meeting:

1. We strongly encouraged you all to listen to the results of the Full Forensic Audit in Maricopa County. We advised you that the findings of the Full Forensic Audit in Maricopa County lasted approximately three hours and were an essential listen to understanding the process of a Full Forensic Audit.
2. We also informed you we did not know the cost of a Full Forensic Audit. As you may recall, Crickett mentioned that should we proceed with a Full Forensic Audit, it may render our election machines invalid and the county has spent millions of dollars on these machines, once again, I will take this opportunity to remind you that as a tax paying citizen of Parker County my vote does not have a price.
3. We also informed you that the current audits happening in the four counties in Texas are not comparable to the Maricopa County Audits and therefore are NOT Full Forensic Audits.
4. We informed you that the only person that would have the answer to your question about what a Full Forensic Audit would entail is Senator Wendy Rogers from Arizona.

5. We explained that the reason Senator Wendy Rogers from Arizona is the only person with the information regarding a Full Forensic Audit is because Maricopa County in Arizona is the first and to date the ONLY county brave enough to conduct a Full Forensic Audit.

6. As to the discrepancies in the four different sources provided in our power point that yielded three different vote totals, there simply is no excuse for this. Crickett stated that (I'm paraphrasing) It takes a while for the system to update. Does it take eleven months to update the system?

7. Furthermore, with regards to the meager defense as to why SLI had expired certifications, therefore HART certifications were also expired, again, there is no excuse. Please refer to the HAVA Act and State Election Laws. This would be akin to having your car inspected eleven months too late and expecting the car inspection to be valid from the date of inspection for a full year because you didn't get caught. As I am sure you are well aware, it doesn't work that way.

8. Included in our power point presentation is a video from Captain Seth Keshel, former U.S. Army Veteran who served as a Military Intelligence Officer in which Captain Keshel took the time to break down anomalies based on statistical data specifically in Parker County. Captain Keshel has been traveling the country speaking about election integrity and is also a resident of Parker County.

After much prayer and consideration, Jenn and I have decided it is now time to include our Sheriff, Russ Authier in this e-mail, all county Commissioners and Pat Deen. As John Forrest pointed out several times in our meeting on October 20, 2021 if a Full Forensic Audit is conducted and the audit capitulates a verdict similar to those in Maricopa County, Felonies will have been committed.

This is our fourth and FINAL request to be added to the Commissioner's Court Agenda, preferably in an EMERGENCY session as time is of the essence, to exercise our 1st Amendment rights to protect our 14th Amendment, that we have thus far been denied.
